

The Rum University Offers a Two-Day Training Seminar in Madrid

The Rum University announces the first stop in its European Education Tour. Madrid, Spain, will be the host city for an intense, 2-day course for beverage sector professionals.

Rum cocktails like the Mojito and the Daiquiri have left an indelible mark in the world and Tiki cocktails owe their existence to this magical elixir.

This will mark the first time such a rum-centric curriculum has been offered in Spain. All industry members are encouraged to attend, but in order to guarantee the best possible learning environment, registration will be limited only to the first 100 people.
